Reuters: English press agency (London, good source for financial news and news from former British colonies in Asia). **AFP:** Agence France Presse (French, very good for news from France and previous French colonies in Africa). **AP:** Associated Press (USA, 'the world's oldest and largest newsgathering organisation; extensive network of correspondents). **DPA:** Deutsche Presse-Agentur (Germany, good source for news about Germany and Eastern Europe). **KNA:** Kyodo News Agency (Japan, primarily news on Japan). **IPS:** Inter Press Service ('the world's leading provider of information on global issues'; developing countries' press agency set up to tackle the news monopoly of the western press agencies).
